

HENSTRIDGE VILLAGE FETE 21st June 2025 – STALL HOLDER INFORMATION

Set Up:

Stall set up from 08.30 until 11.30.

The car park and recreation field will be available from 08.30 until 11.30 for stall holders, entertainers and food vendors to set up. All vehicles must be removed from the area at the end of this time unless by prior arrangement. The gates will be re-opened briefly at 15.00 to allow exit for any classic cars/bikes but will otherwise remain closed.

The Fete will be opened at Noon by Sarah Dyke, our local Member for Parliament.

Parking:

Free parking for vendors has been arranged in the field next to the Virginia Ash pub (entry is via the Ash car park) Please collect your parking voucher from the Information tent before you vacate the Rec.

Leaving:

Gates will be reopened at 17.00 for stall holders to pack up and leave the site. Please ensure that you vacate the site by 18.00.

Cancellation: If we cancel the fete we will refund your stall fee.

Location: Our fete takes place on the Recreation Ground behind our village hall. Your stall location is sited on the attached map.

Paperwork requirements;

You should have provided us with the following unless we have arranged otherwise.

- All Traders Public liability insurance at least £3 million or if you have arranged through us we will hold this information.
- Food Traders – Food Hygiene Certificates
- Food Traders - Allergen's poster **MUST** be displayed.

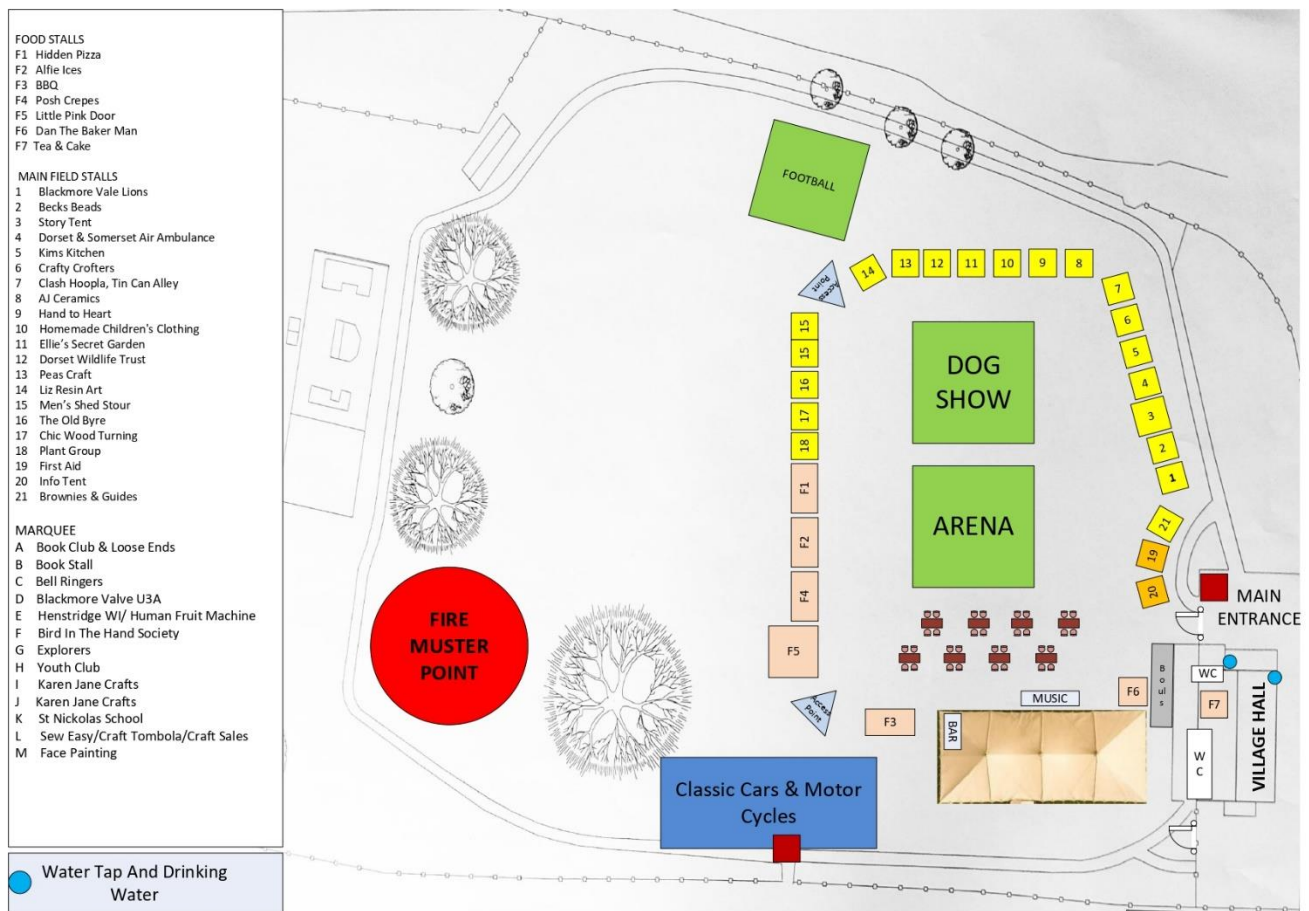
Terms and Conditions:

- You must arrive and set up within the designated set up times If you arrive after 11 am you will not be allowed to set up.
- You must have your stall in situ for the entire fete (12.00am-5pm) unless given express permission by the fete management team that you can pack away early on inclement days.
- If the weather is inclement, we will notify you by 4 pm the day before if the fete is to be cancelled. If we cancel the fete your stall fees will be refunded. If you decide not to turn up due to inclement weather or for any other reason, then you forfeit your stall fee and you may run the risk of not being selected for the next fete.
- No naked flames, gas cylinders or generators are permitted on site and vehicles engines must be switched off. Exemptions apply for food traders.
- You must provide your own gazebo and table unless other arrangements have been made.

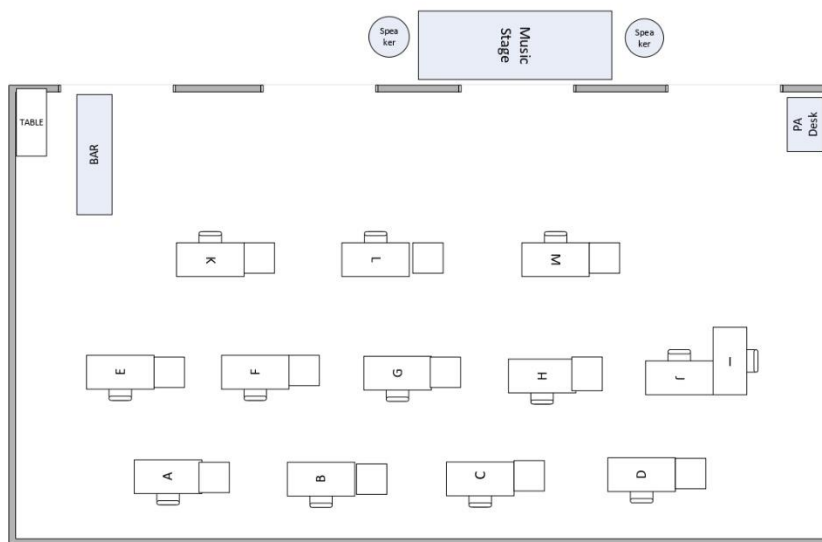
- You must take home all your own waste and rubbish at the end of each day.
- Any issues or incidents must be reported to the Information Tent as soon as possible.
- The fete manager's decision about any issue is final on the day and we reserve the right to enforce the rules set out above.
- Stall holders not complying with safety rules and others Ts & Cs expressed here will be asked to leave the fete immediately (and without refund of stall fees).
- Only Assistance Dogs are permitted on stalls please.
